## Visit from the Rotary Club Nyon-la-Côte



February began with a visit from two members of the Swiss Rotary Club of Nyon-la-Côte, Sébastien Botteron, orthodontist and Olivier Bachelard, gynaecologist-

obstetrician. Their main mission was to assess 1. The state of the hospital; 2. The possibility of setting

up a dental practice and the possibility of strengthening obstetrical capacities. Both projects plan to use teams of foreign doctors coming once or twice a year to operate on previously identified cases. Sébastien and Olivier also proposed funding for a complete renovation of the operating theatre and a new ECG machine funded by their Rotary Club and private donations.






