#### **Internet Comes to MCH**

En We are very happy to announce that, following several months of work, MCH is finally connected to the outside world again! A complete setup of one dozen workstations connected to a central server and high speed Internet have been installed. This allows for file and information sharing, which are vital components to the smooth functioning of our medical

infrastructure. Rainy season is particularly hard on these installations, and we hope that this one will last a long time.





After more than one year of complete closure due to the Ebola emergency, schools have finally reopened. While schools were closed over the past year, students listened to a curriculum broadcast over the radio by the government. A census of school-aged children was taken and we are waiting for results. In order to make up for lost time, the government has decided that school will continue through the summer, with no vacation time. The Ebola crisis created many orphans, and life remains precarious for them, as no relatives are willing to take them out of fearfulness. In response, SSLDF will soon start construction of an orphanage that will include a school, with the capacity to accommodate approximately 120 orphans when completed.

Following the Ebola crisis, famine is a countrywide specter. Thanks to special donations from donors around the globe, SSLDF was able to make several food distributions to some of the most vulnerable individuals, including our sponsored school children.
